


82) The Neo-Babylonian chronicle about Sabium and Apil-Sin: a copy of the text (BM 29440) — Here I offer a copy of BM 29440, a Neo-Babylonian tablet previously published with a photograph by E. Leichty and C.B.F. Walker, "Three Babylonian Chronicle and Scientific Texts," in G. Frame (ed.), *From the Upper Sea to the Lower Sea. Studies on the History of Assyria and Babylonia in Honour of A.K. Grayson*. Istanbul 2004, 203-212 (no. 2, pp. 205-211). The tablet contains a brief chronicle about the Old-Babylonian dynasty, besides a number of astronomical and metrical notitions. The tablet hails from Borsippa and dates roughly to the Neo-Babylonian or early Persian period. I wish to thank the Trustees of the British Museum for permission to publish the copy of this tablet here. It measures 11,1 x 10,3 cm.
