

Ummanšipir the Elamite — *Um-man-ši-pir* the Elamite Böhl Leiden Coll. III 49 No. 878 : 2f. (see Zadok Elamite Onomasticon = *Annali Suppl.* 40 [1984], 12; Hinz and Koch *Elamisches Wörterbuch* [1987] 1231; Dandamayev *Iranians in Babylonia* [1992], 150) must be the same man as *Um-man-še-pir* the Elamite CT 57 212 : 2f. If so, the former text comes, like the latter, from the reign of Nabopolassar, and the man's description as NIM.MA.[KI]-ú CT 57 212 : 3 confirms that LÚ *I-la-mu-u* Böhl Leiden Coll. III 49 No. 878 : 3 (coll. Bongenaar, pace Dandamayev, *Zadok Rép. géogr.* 8 132) is the gentilic, «Elamite». Similarly LÚ *I-la-mu-ú* BM 74491 : 8 apud Jursa *Landwirtschaft in Sippar* (AfO Beih. 25) 53 n. 100.
